Town of Pineville Breaks Ground on New Electrical Substation

PINEVILLE, NC – The Town of Pineville is proud to announce the groundbreaking ceremony for its new electrical substation, scheduled for March 24, 2025, at 2:00 PM. The substation, located at 12499 Nations Ford Road, will be Pineville's fourth substation, significantly enhancing the town's electrical infrastructure to support continued growth and economic development.

Construction is set to begin in April and has an anticipated completion date for spring 2026. This \$8 million investment in Pineville's future will be fully funded by electric rate revenues, ensuring that no tax dollars are used for this project.

The new substation is being developed in response to increased demand from both industrial and residential growth, including the McCullough community, Carolina Logistics Park, Cone Mill Property Development, College Street Development, Coventry Subdivision, Miller Farms Subdivision, and other future expansion projects. The additional electrical capacity provided by this facility will ensure reliable electric service and system redundancy, benefiting Pineville for years to come.

Residents and stakeholders are invited to join town officials and project partners for the groundbreaking ceremony on March 24, 2025, at 2:00 PM at the substation site.
